US Academic Policies 2011

Licensing Requirements

Academic licenses are available to accredited, degree granting institutions for use in teaching and basic research. SIMULIA software results must be openly and freely available to the public.

Institutions wishing to license SIMULIA software must provide the following items:

- 1) Academic Software License Agreement signed by an authorized representative of the institution. The signed agreement may be faxed or emailed to expedite your order.
- 2) Contact information for the Responsible Person (RP) including name, shipping address, phone number, and fax number.
- 3) Credit card information or a copy of your purchase order depending on intended payment method.
- 4) The host ID for your license server. Instructions are available from the SIMULIA Online Support System (Abagus Answer ID 1269).

License Agreement and Terms of Use

Academic pricing and licenses are available only to qualifying institutions that have signed a "Software License Agreement for Academic Institutes" with Dassault Systèmes Simulia Corp.

Abaqus Teaching Edition(s) are for classroom and instructional teaching purposes only and shall not be used for academic research.

The Abaqus Research Edition is for research purposes and may also be used for instructional teaching. Results from work done with Abaqus Research Edition must reference Abaqus and be made publicly available. No Abaqus academic programs may be used for any consulting work generating commercial fees. Short term commercial license are available to Abaqus Research Edition licensees.

Support

Academic licenses do not include technical support. Technical support can be purchased separately—contact your sales representative for details. Only the current and the previous version of the software are eligible for a technical or installation support contract. In exceptional circumstances, and at our discretion, we will provide a license file for older versions of the software during the term of a license. Tokens required for such legacy use are subject to the current token pricing.

Installation support will be provided for 30 days upon the start or renewal of your license or receipt of a license file.





Prices Outside the US

Canada is subject to US pricing with a 10% surcharge. Other international accounts will need to contact the local sales office or value added reseller for academic pricing.

Installation and Documentation

Research, Teaching, and Student Edition licenses include online documentation in HTML and PDF formats. Sets of printed program documentation can be purchased from your sales representative. See the documentation price list under the support link at www.simulia.com for availability and pricing of printed documentation.

Updates

The latest release of Abaqus will be provided upon the start or renewal of a license. Upon request, the latest maintenance release or general release of Abaqus will be made available to current academic licensees for an update fee of \$100.

Revision Fee Minimum Charge

The cost of changes made during the license period (for example purchasing additional analysis tokens) will be pro-rated to the next renewal date. All changes, including changes to the license servers, the products licensed, and the addition of network tokens are subject to a minimum charge of \$100 per transaction.

Payment Terms

Payment is due in full within 30 days from the invoice date. Late payments incur a charge of 1.5% of the unpaid balance per month.

VISA and MasterCard credit card payments are accepted.

All prices include shipping via UPS or similar carrier. Outside the USA shipping charges are net of import duties or tariffs.

Prices are exclusive of any state or local tax and are subject to change. This price list supersedes all previous price lists. Price quotations are valid for 30 days.
